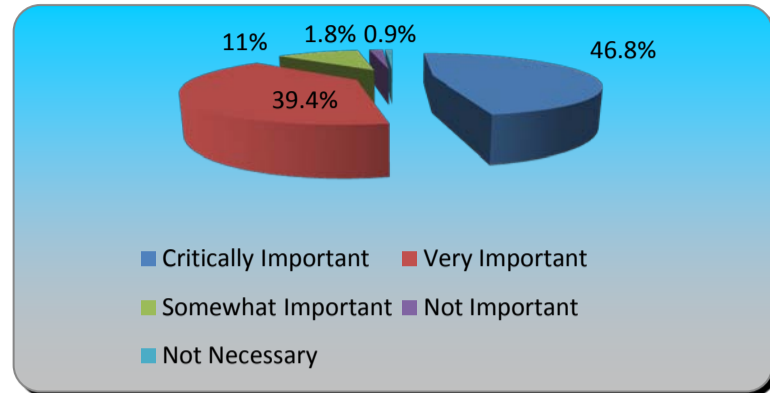


RTCA 2011 Annual Symposium - Session 5 ARS Results

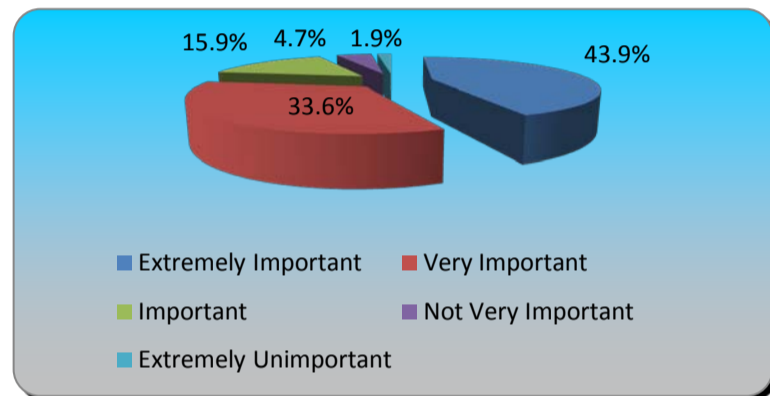
1) On a scale of 1 – 5, how important is it to have globally harmonized performance standards? (multiple choice) **Responses**

Critically Important	46.79%
Very Important	39.45%
Somewhat Important	11.01%
Not Important	1.83%
Not Necessary	0.92%
Totals	100%



2) On a scale of 1-5, with 1 being the most important, how important is it for the international aviation community to harmonize air traffic modernization efforts? (multiple choice) **Responses**

Extremely Important	43.93%
Very Important	33.64%
Important	15.89%
Not Very Important	4.67%
Extremely Unimportant	1.87%
Totals	100%



3) Technology and, in some cases, procedures are relatively easy to harmonize at an international level but the human factors aspects seem to come under far less scrutiny. Do you believe the human-computer interface for pilots and controllers is having sufficient attention paid to it in the current harmonization efforts? (multiple choice) **Responses**
