• The RTCA Anti-Trust, Proprietary, and Committee Participation Membership Policy statements were displayed and read through by Karan, and were accepted by the participants and recorded in these minutes.

#### Welcome/Discussions

- The RTCA SC-216 committee chairman Dave Pierce welcomed the group and stated
  that the objective of the meeting is to discuss the addition of ED-205A to our RTCASC-216 ToR. Dave explained that this would be an expansion of our scope at the
  request of the FAA. He added that Boeing, Delta, and the FAA are in favour of the
  update and have encouraged this revision.
- The proposed change to the ToR was presented. The change stated that RTCA SC-216 committee would work jointly with EUROCAE WG-72 to revise existing ED-205 and publish as a new RTCA document.
- Dave stated that the document has a short turnaround revision time. Karan said that, when approved, a document DO number would be added with FRAC. Dave asked for members interested in advocating for the proposal to send an email with a writeup in favour of the change.
- Dave asked for a vote in favour or against the proposal. The votes were counted and 18 members have voted in support of the proposal, one member abstained out of the 24-membership attendance.
