1. RTCA Policy Presentation

- Al Secen and Alex Engel read several standard policy statements (Policy Slides Joint RTCA EUROCAE.pdf)
- 2. Co-Chairs Welcome, Introductions, and Remarks
 - Jessie convened the October 21, 2021 meeting by welcoming all in attendance.
 Participants were identified based on the WebEx participant list and the AerOpus website
- 3. Review of Meeting Agenda.
 - Jessie reviewed the agenda
- 4. Review/Approval of the 81st Meeting Summary
 - The minutes from the Aug 16th 2021 plenary (#81) were posted to the AerOpus website
 - The minutes were approved

- 5. Opening of the Open Consultation/FRAC of Draft Change 1 to DO-260C/ED-102B
 - Topic Lead: Tom Pagano
 - ADS-B MOPS re-opened with primary objective to incorporate needed changes from the published DO-260C
 - FRAC starts October 26 and ends December 10 2021
 - CSC telecons to resolve comments December 15-16, 2021
 - Final Change 1 document to be available to RTCA and EUROCAE following approval at the scheduled December 17 2021 Plenary meeting
 - Change 1 Summary Document Length is ~150 pages
 - Added requirements
 - ADS-B receiver version in Operational Status Message to resolve backward compatibility issue with Traffic Uplink Management Message
 - 2. PIC limiting, consistent with NIC limiting
 - Test procedure corrections
 - Editorial corrections including improvements in clarity
 - 1. Table corrections
 - 2. Section reference corrections
 - Mike Garcia asked if anything significant comes up during FRAC, will the schedule for approval of Change 1 adjust accordingly
 - Tom and Jessie concurred
 - Doug Arbuckle pointed out that its relatively common to have the plenary approval soon after the comment resolution meetings
 - Tom also mentioned that the FRAC scope will be limited to what's in the Change 1 document (not the entirety of the full MOPS)
 - Martin pointed out that High comments and Non-Concurs can be resolved prior to the end of FRAC/OC
 - Alex stated that there may be some formatting issues with the current draft of Change 1 that may need to be resolved prior to FRAC/OC
 - Tim said the formatting differences are consistent with recent MOPS change documents (e.g. DO-361A)
 - Al asked Tim if the tracked changes version can be posted as part of the FRAC process to make it easier to review
 - CSC seeks SC-186 Plenary to approve entering FRAC for DO-260C Change 1
 - Jessie made a motion to move forward
 - Alex made a similar motion to the EUROCAE members
 - Motion was seconded and approved

 - Harmonize UAT with 1090ES ADS-B Standards
 - Address errors, omissions, clarifications, changes
