- 1. Co-Chairs Welcome, Introductions, and Remarks
 - Jessie convened the July 15, 2022 meeting by welcoming all in attendance. Participants were identified based on the WebEx participant list and the AerOpus website
- 2. RTCA and EUROCAE Policy Presentation
 - Brandi Teel and Alex Engel read several standard policy statements (RTCA Policy Slides.pdf)
- 3. Review/Approval of Meeting Agenda.
 - Rocky reviewed the agenda
- 4. Review/Approval of the 85th Meeting Summary
 - The minutes from the March 25, 2022 plenary were posted to the AerOpus website
 - The minutes were approved
- 5. RTCA SC-186 WG-4 / EUROCAE WG-51 SG-3 ADS-B In Applications Status
 - Topic Lead: Lesley Weitz
 - Updated group plan

- Strengthen white paper impact by including industry perspectives on ADS-B IN applications
 - a. SC-186 WG-4/WG-51 SG-3 leadership will develop a template for industry input
 - b.
- An updated schedule was shown for this plan
- Planning to delivery final white paper to SC-186/WG-51 chairs by Oct 14
- Discussed that a formal FRAC would not be needed for the white paper to go to the PMC, but a plenary high level approval would be warranted
- Lesley reviewed the survey that was used regarding ADS-B In applications to get industry feedback
- 6. Advanced Air Mobility (AAM) Surveillance Spectrum (SC-228 Activity Support)
 - Topic Lead: Jessie Turner
 - A Vehicle to Vehicle/Ground White paper is being worked on by this group. This includes some feasibility studies. The target date for completion is Dec 2022.
 - One of the gaps identified by the group is a lack of a surveillance approach for AAM applications
- 7. Other Business
 - SC-242/WG-124 Spectrum Compatibility and RF Information Request
 - Topic Lead: Jessie Turner
 - In order to prevent future negative impacts and equip aviation with a strategic solution to guarantee long-term sustainable access to spectrum required for growth, RTCA and EUROCAE have started joint Special Committee (SC) 242/Working Group (WG) 124 on Spectrum Compatibility
 - The ultimate goal of the activity is to provide guidance material for future new and revised standards to ensure that the RF characteristics of aeronautical systems are complete and are fit-for-purpose in the evolving spectrum environment, while respecting the necessary safety margins
 - The guidance is intended to facilitate any future evaluation of compatibility with other systems
 - Doug Arbuckle recommended that Jessie reach out to Tom Pagano and Eric Potier to review their work on the ICAO Surveillance Panel
 - Pairwise Trajectory Management (PTM) Discussion
 - Topic Lead: Jessie Turner
 - Jessie showed a PTM paper from the ICAO SASP (Warburton, Mauer, Kessler, and Beritsky)
 - Doug gave an overview of the FAA perspective and planned activities with respect to PTM
 - a. FAA brought the Pairwise Trajectory Management (PTM) concept to the ICAO Separation and Airspace Safety Panel

(SASP) to see if there were other ICAO States working on similar techniques, so that any new SASP work under a proposed job card would be representative of worldwide interest.

- b. The FAA has a cadre of personnel that knows how to develop avionics standards for ADS-B In applications as well as the associated ATC automation requirements, but after FY22 funding runs out, the FAA is not expected to receive any funding to do such work in FY23 since no funding was requested in the President's FY23 budget.
- c. Therefore, there are no near-term plans within the FAA to pursue avionics standards development for PTM. However, the FAA Future of the Ocean 2035 (FOTO35) project is interested in the PTM concept for the envisioned future of oceanic operations
