1. Welcome and Administrative Remarks:

Ms. Hofmann opened the meeting with the reading of the reminders for Anti-Trust Requirement, RTCA Proprietary Policy and Membership Policy and relevant exemptions, as well as RTCA membership requirements. Dr. Wilkinson presented the agenda for today's meeting.

The Summary for the Plenary #92 (September 28, 2023) meeting was reviewed and approved.

3. TSA Report:

Mr. Chavez had nothing to report relevant to the committee; TSA/DHS are currently focused on other issues.

4. Safe Skies Reports:

Ms. Guzik had nothing new to report regarding the Guidelines update, still a few months from completion and issuance.

5. Final Review and Comment Resolution (FRAC) of DO-230M:

The committee received 16 comments from the FRAC as reflected in the Comment Spreadsheet. All were categorized as High. All comments were addressed and resolved.

With resolution complete, all members agreed the final version should be forwarded to the Program Management Committee for final approval and publication.

6. Additional Notes:

Dr. Wilkinson reported on PARAS-52 which focuses on strategic facilitation and arrivals issues; he notes it is very good guidance for architects and designers, but virtually useless for this committee's purposes and content. PARAS documents, often viewed by industry by some s mostly primers, this updated document offers not much new information for our committee.

There was some discussion of potential RTCA webinar to advertise/disseminate the new version.

Also, possible speaker(s) at international conferences (Munich, Frankfurt in early 2024).

Possible future additional text regarding pro/con of various technologies, including AI.
