Minutes of Meeting

1. Introductions and Welcome

Rebecca Morrison opened the virtual plenary meeting.

3. Review and approve minutes from May 2024 Plenary

Daniel Chiew reviewed the meeting minutes for the prior plenary meeting (RTCA SC-213 #54 / EUROCAE WG-79 #48).

[MOTION]: Randy Bailey motioned to approve the meeting minutes. Troy Niles seconded. No opposed. Motion passed.

4. Comment Resolution Meeting from FRAC/OC EFVS (WG-2) MASPS

Randy Bailey provided an update on FRAC comment resolution. Seven additional comments were received and were addressed, completing the resolution of all received comments. It was noted that EASA was not present to confirm the suitability of the resolution of their non-concur comments.

[MOTION]: Randy Bailey motioned to close FRAC resolution and to submit the WG-2 MASPS document for further processing towards release. Daniel Chiew seconded. No opposed. Motion passed.

WG-1

Thea Feyereisen reported WG-1 had no ongoing work, having completed FRAC resolution at the last plenary in Köln.

WG-4

Esther Hoyas provided an update on WG-4 activities and the result of the "Call for Industry Interest for Vision Systems in Innovative Aerial Services (IAS) within WG-79". Broad interest was received, indicating support for expanding ED-255 and the need for a future workshop. A hybrid workshop is planned for September 12 4-6pm CET. Following details to be discussed at the workshop, scope update will be presented to EUROCAE TAC (mid-September meeting), followed by a subsequent recommendation to RTCA PMC to join in that activity.

[ACTION 55-3]: Esther Hoyas to distribute the presentation containing the results of EUROCAE call for interest.

[ACTION 55-4]: Carlo and Esther to schedule the workshop to discuss Vision Systems for IAS prior to September TAC meeting.

The committee reaffirmed the plans for a Face-to-Face + Virtual Plenary, October 15-17, hosted by RTCA in Washington, DC, USA.

7. Other Business

Possible TOR Expansion

In addition to the IAS scope expansion in WG-4, a TOR expansion to include "fly-by-video" topics and technology was discussed. Broad participant interest was raised for both window replacement and flight-control applications. This TOR expansion will be one of the agenda items of the October plenary.

MASPS Participant Listing

The committee discussed which participants to list in the standards with a desire to indicate the active participants who contributed to the MASPS development while also satisfying the RTCA & EUROCAE templates and policies for listing all members of the Special Committee / Working Group. The committee decided to identify both the active and member participants in the MASPS.

[ACTION 55-5]: WG leads to send active participants list to Rebecca Morrison by 25 August.
